








Rules

- (2) Never use more than 1 or 2 designs /borders
- (3) Never use more than 1 to 3 colors /borders.
- (4) Persevere to complete.


Purpose

To practice strokes, to make something attractive, & to develop perseverance.

<p>Bars</p>	<p>1. Slant lines from top down. 2. Color bars</p>	
<p>Rope</p>	<p>1. Wavy lines 2. Color rope.</p>	
<p>Glow</p>	<p>1. Swoop lines from bottom up. 2. Color glow.</p>	
<p>Lace</p>	<p>1. Long "e"s. 2. Scallop tops.</p>	
<p>Lace 2</p>	<p>1. Fat "m"s 2. Cluster 3 tiny circles</p>	
<p>Beads</p>	<p>1. Full circles. 2. Color in dark outsides to lighter centers.</p>	
<p>Cardinals</p>	<p>1. "s"s 2. Add eye, beak. 3. Color bird red.</p>	
<p>Philodendron</p>	<p>1. No. 3's, closed 2. Wavy line, stem 3. Green leaves.</p>	
<p>Lines</p>	<p>1. With ruler, make a thick and thin line. Color.</p>	

“c”
Begin at 2:00
position on
dotted line and
go left making
a round open
circle.

“C”
Begin near top
line at 2:00
position and
make a large
open-ended
circle.

ending from

line.

“e”

Swoop to the
dotted line,
curving back
for a loop, go
down & cross
first swoop
near the bottom
line, then touch
bottom line,
swoop, and lift
for a little
ending.
