

Catholic Church Latin Pronunciation Guide (From a Latin Grammar by Scanlon)

Long Vowel (*Short vowel sounds are very close to long vowel sounds and are therefore not listed.-MP*)

— a as in father: Amen, ad, mater

— e as in they: me, video

— i as in machine: qui, ire, tibi

— o as in or: Deo, omnis

— u as in rule: tu, cum, sumus

Diphthong = two vowels joined to produce one sound

ae as in say: saecula, illae, Esseiae, aeternam

oe as in say: coelum, coepi

au as in how: laudo, exaudi, causam

Exceptions are marked with diaeresis (‘) over the second vowel and the vowels are pronounced separately: Michaëlum, poëma

Consonants are pronounced as in English with the following exceptions.

ce, ci as in church: fecit, lucem, (also) coelum

ch as in ache: Christus, Archangelum

ge, gi as in gentle: genta, agit

gn as ny in canyon: agnus, dignus

h is silent: homine, habemus, Thomas

j (and consonant i) as y in yes: Jesus, justus, juventutem, Joannem, Judica, Iudeo

s as in sing (never as z): misereatur, vos

sce, sci as sh in shall: discerne, Suscipiat

ti (but not sti, tti or xti) as tsee: gratia, totiusque

ex + a vowel, h or s as gs: exaudi

(r may be rolled very slightly with the tip of tongue on palate)

Syllables – A Latin word has as many syllables as it has vowels and diphthongs: Ideo = I-de-o

Accent – The accent or stress of a Latin word is never on the last syllable. A syllable marked with an accent('') is pronounced with slightly more stress.

Mass Server's Card

Server. When the priest has vested, with hands joined, bow with him to the crucifix and walk before him to the sanctuary. At the door touch his fingers with holy water, bless yourself and ring the sacristy bell. At the center of the altar steps receive his biretta, genuflect with him and place the biretta on the celebrant's bench. Return to the center, genuflect and kneel on the floor at left.

At the Confiteor

Priest bows low and says the Confiteor

P. Confiteor ... ad Dominum Deum nostrum.

Server remains erect. At the end, server bows toward the priest and says:

S. Misereatur tui omnipotens Deus, et dimissis peccatis tuis, perducat te ad vitam aeternam.

P. Amen.

Server bows head and shoulders toward the altar and says:

S. Confiteor Deo omnipotenti beatae Mariae semper Virgini, beato Michaeli Archangelo, beato Joanni Baptista, sanctis Apostolis Petro et Paulo, omnibus Sanctis, et tibi Pater, (turn toward the priest, then front) quia peccavi nimis cogitatione,

verbo, et opera: (Strike your breast three times), mea culpa, mea culpa, mea maxima culpa. Ideo precor beatam Mariam semper Virginem, beatum Michaelem Archangelum, beatum Joannem Baptistam, sanctos Apostolos Petrum et Paulum, omnes Sanctos, et te, Pater, (Turn toward the priest) orare pro me ad Dominum Deum nostrum. Priest says "Misereatur," etc.

Server answers "Amen" and kneels erect.

P. Misereatur ... aeternam.

S. Amen.

At the Indulgentiam

Priest blesses himself while saying "Indulgentiam" etc.

Server also blesses himself.

P. Indulgentiam ... Dominus.

S. Amen.

Priest bows his head while saying "Deus, tu conversus" etc.

Server also bows his head.

P. Deus, tu conversus vivificabis nos.

S. Et plebs tua laetabitur in te.

P. Ostende nobis, Domine, misericordiam tuam.

S. Et salutare tuum da nobis.

P. Domine, exaudi orationem meam.

S. Et clamor meus ad te veniat.

P. Dominus vobiscum.

S. Et cum spiritu tuo.

P. Oremus.

Priest ascends altar steps, kisses the altar, and goes to the Missal.

Server stands erect, then kneels on lowest step at Gospel side.

Priest reads Introit, returns to middle of altar and says:
