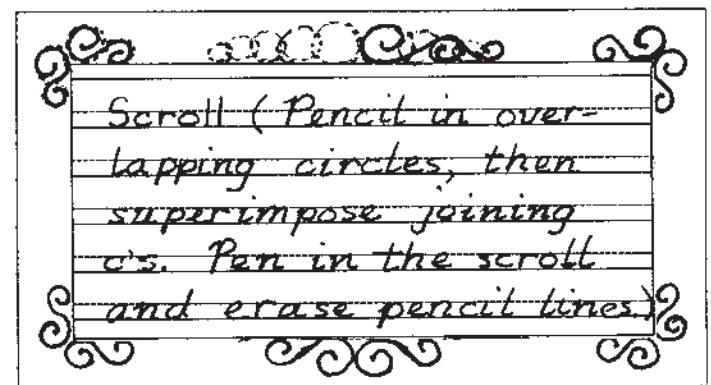
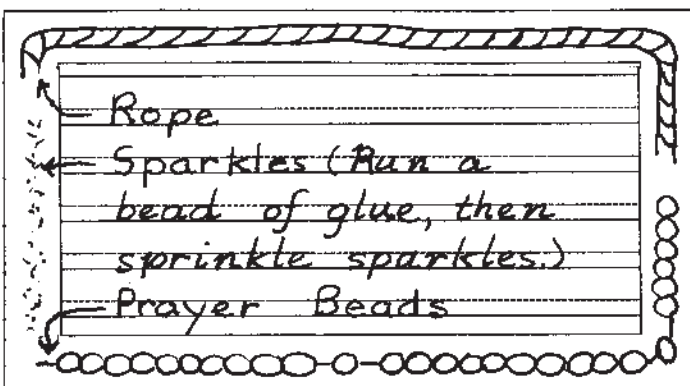
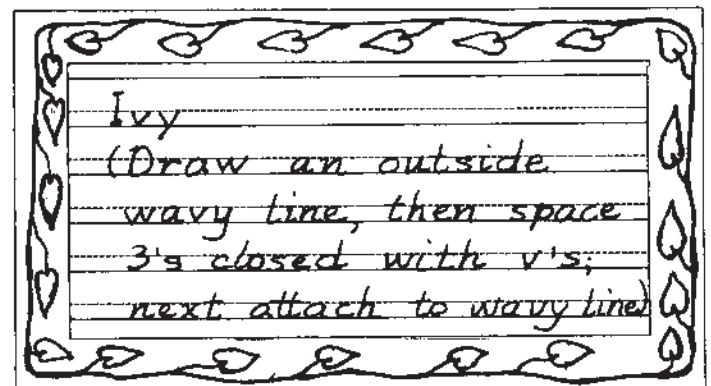
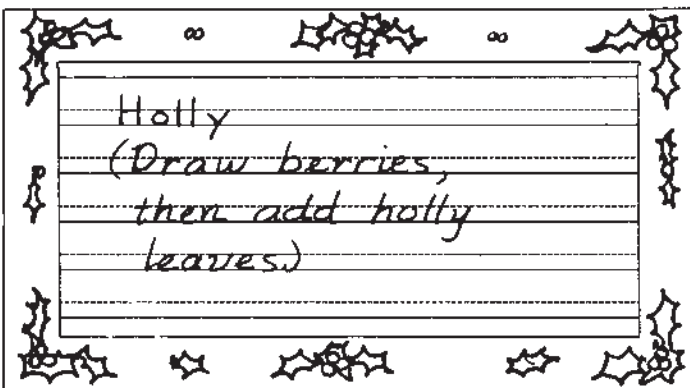
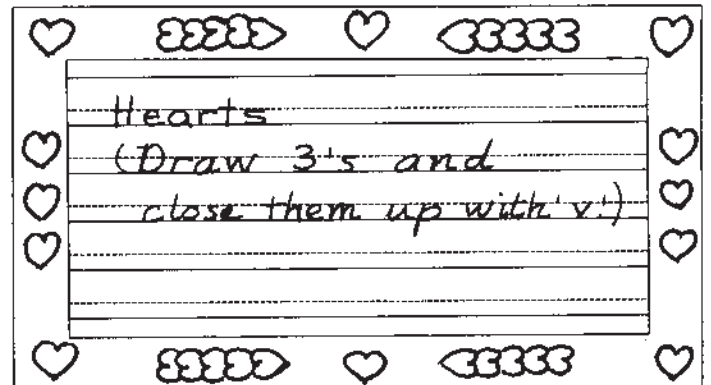
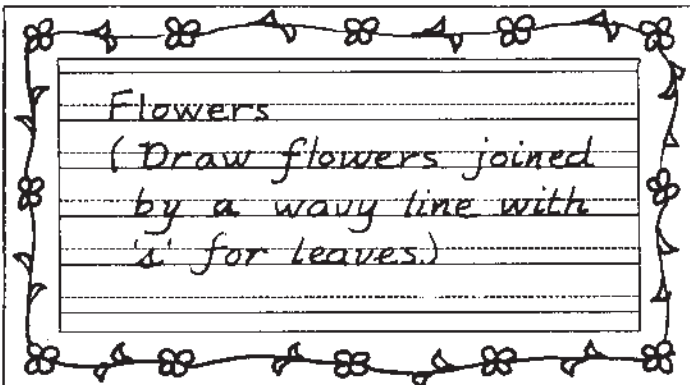
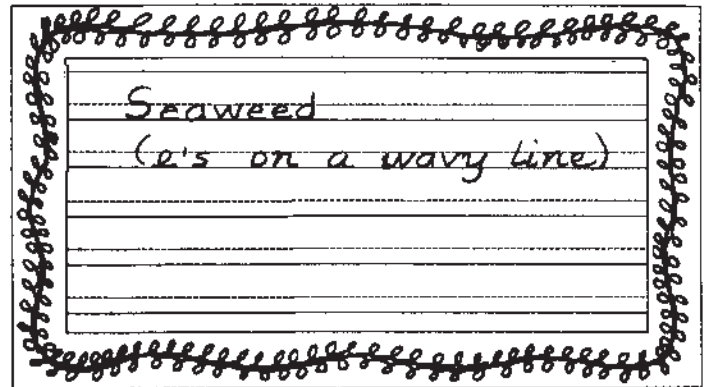
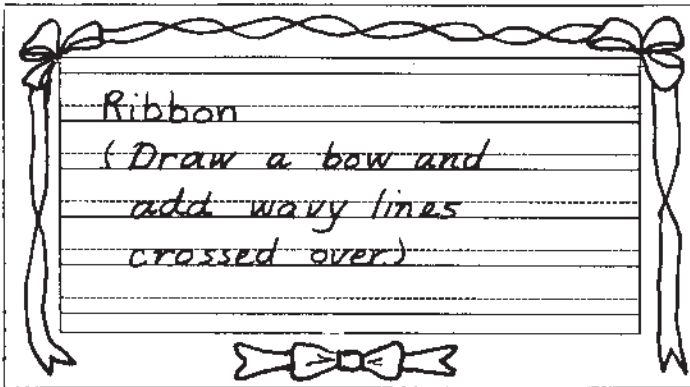


Decorating develops concentration, muscle control, and aesthetics. Decorating your verse carefully makes your card much more appealing. It becomes that special gift you would like to give, to use, or to save. Do try to make the decoration suit the verse. Below are some patterns to try. Begin with pencil to get the right size pattern and spacing; then color it in, and erase the pencil.

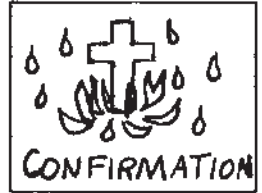

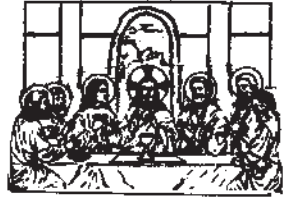
